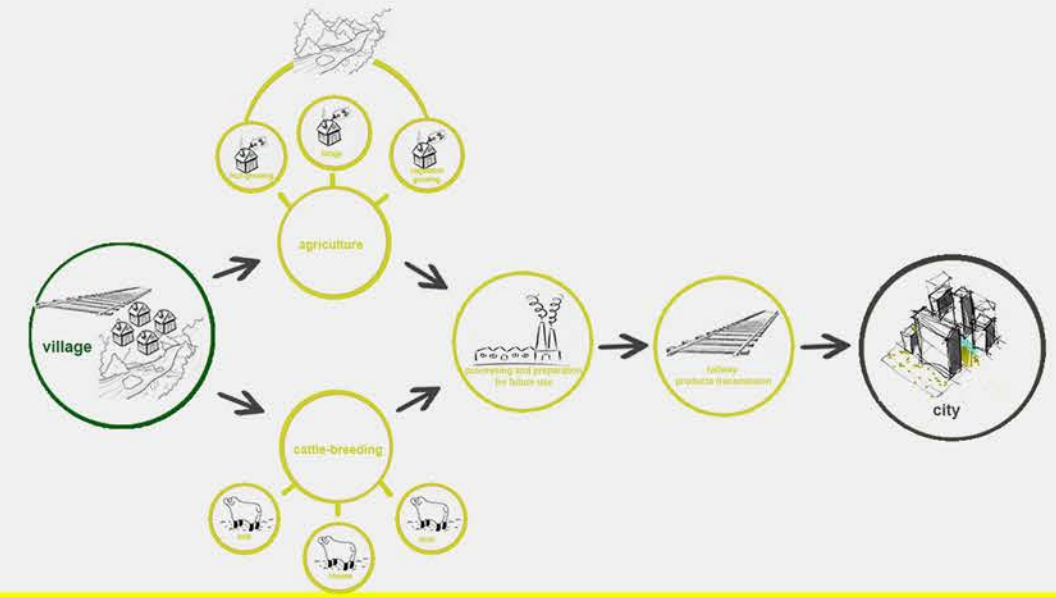
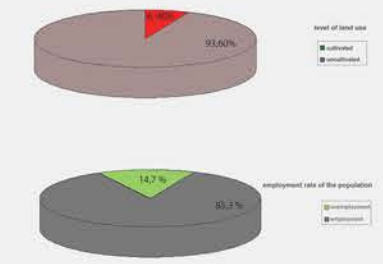


WHAT GOAL: CONNECTING, (COOPERATION, JOINING) IMPROVED LIFE QUALITY

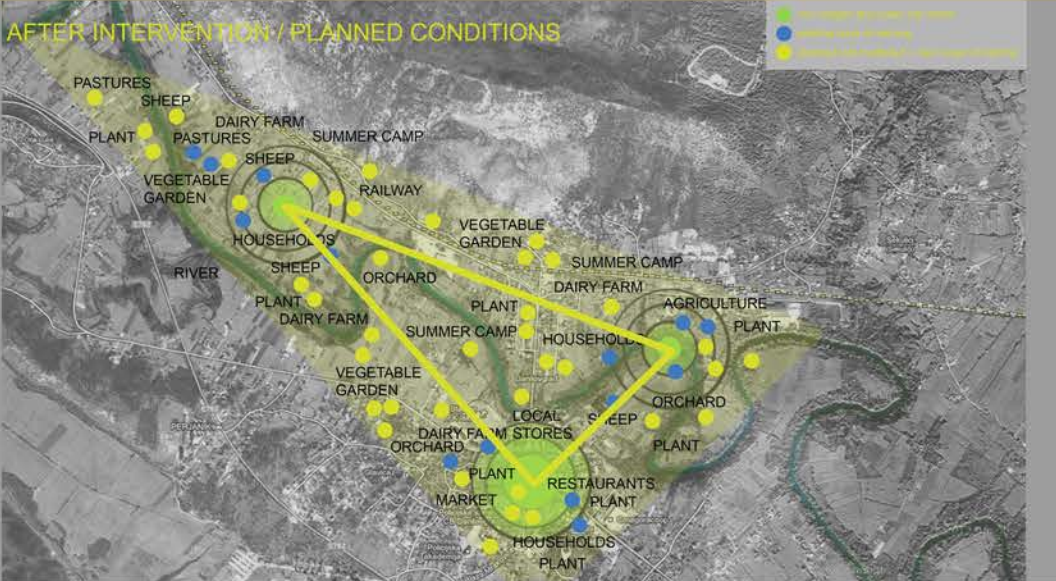
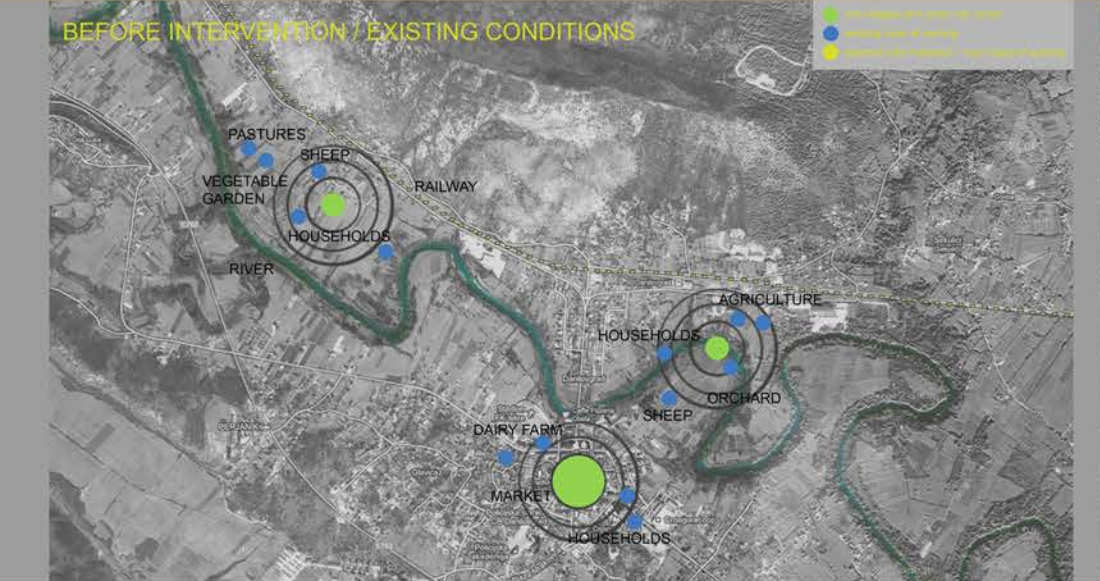

Danilovgrad is a rather **small municipality**, with the area of 500m2, a population of around 18 000 inhabitants, somewhat less than 7 000 living in the urban area. This region is quite **rich in natural resources**, with a very **healthy climate**. The **land** that it consists of is **fertile**, suitable for different kinds of agriculture, surrounded by hills and mountains that provide a rich diet for a number of livestock. Not polluted by gigantic factories and dense traffic, this territory provides excellent investment conditions for creating a sustainable, well organized community. Unfortunately, it's **not using** almost any of its naturally **given potentials**, or any other for that matter. **We need to create** a concept that would result in a very well **organized system**, where all available resources and **potentials are used** in maximum, with a great deal of attention to the environment. Development of agriculture would provide enough **for local use** and further. Not only in the terms of selling it to local markets, **stores and restaurants**, but also in the terms of production of regionally characteristic products for local use and **export**.



A region rich with grassland suitable for breeding all sorts of **livestock**, which results in producing different kinds of goods and products, like **meat, milk products** and **other products** like wool, for exaple.

This region consists of a vast area of arable and cultivable land. It is suitable for **agriculture**; growing all sorts of **vegetables, fruits** and **wheat**. They also serve as bases for creating other traditional products.



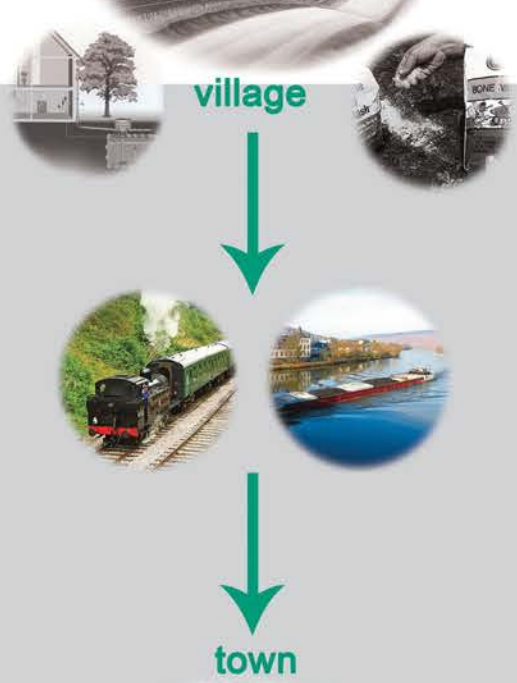
When it comes to **energy preservation** and sufficiency, in-ground built tanks that harvest water from the rain are a good part of the solution.

Transportation of goods would mostly rely on **river** and **railway** transport, cutting down costs and pollution

The geographical position of the municipality, especially the town of Danilovgrad and its surrounding villages, has a great advantage when it comes to **tourism**. It's located near some very important tourist attractions. This provides great opportunities for the growth and development of village tourism.

When a town is revitalized and has a reputation of taking care of and employing its citizens, various activities within the town start to take place. **Markets, restaurants, cafes, shops,** parks, cultural institutions and schools all manage to work properly and keep the inhabitants



The idea is for farmers to **reuse** as much elements as possible. Nothing is thrown away, everything on the farm can be reused, so the farmer has less expenses of necessity.

When it comes to creating job opportunities and motivating youth, there are different **programs, camps and courses** that provide education, practice and insight in future work. Keeping the young population in work and from emigrating is the number one goal when it comes to the sociological aspect of the community.

All products that are in their initial phase are transported by train or boat to local mini factories, which then engage into further processing and making end **products**. These factories would create **new jobs** and would be enough to supply the local market and set



When the products finally make it to the town, they are then distributed to the local market and grocery stores.
