

GREEN.BUILDING.SOLUTIONS. (GBS) Summer University 2020

First-hand ecological knowledge and engineering expertise is bundled in a three-week program in the capital of energy-efficient and green building: Vienna. The UNESCO-awarded international program is geared towards students primarily at the graduate level who study architecture and engineering sciences; however, anyone with a background in a built environment-related field is welcome. There are also students and professionals from facility management, urban planning, landscape architecture and policy development.

The [GBS Summer University](#) is co-organized by an excellent consortium of over 30 national and international scientific organizations, and is implemented by the [OEAD-Housing Office](#) together with the [BOKU University](#) and the [TU Wien](#). Upon completion of 175 hours of course work, students receive 7 ECTS-credits. The program is split into two weeks of lectures, workshops, exercises, and excursions, with the third week dedicated to designing a group project incorporating the knowledge gained during the first two weeks.

The main topics of the 3-week program are

- Sustainability in Building and Urban Planning,
- Principles of Passive house planning and
- Renewable Energies and Business Concepts.

The date for the upcoming GBS is **19 July to 08 August 2020**.

Tuition: € 2,490 for professionals and €2,000 for students. Tuition costs include accommodation in a passive house student dormitory, local transit, and admission to extra-curricular activities. Students who are highly qualified but have lack on financial resources can apply for a scholarship, reduced fee are € 490 including all program components.

Registration deadline for scholarships / credits: March 31, 2020.

General application deadline: June 30, 2020.
