Each university (Belgrade, Unicam, Cyprus) will take to Lisbon 5 students. Iscte has 6 students (to confirm, some are working students). So, we have 21 students.

We organize 4 working tables. Each table will have at least one student from each university, addressing the international and the socialization vision of Erasmus project.

Each table will have a Local workshop's topic. For example, one table will talk about the local workshop done in Lisbon, the other one about Valjevo, the other one about San Benedetto del Tronto e the last one about Nicosia.

In each table students will talk about the tools and the results of the local workshop in question. They will choose together at least one tool used from other university that they would like to implement in this workshop.

There will not be time to implement a full tool in a few days, but students can delineate an imaginary scenario starting from this tool, explaining why they are interested in that tools for that case study and what objectives they would like to achieve with that tool.

In that imaginary scenario for the case study in question, they describe a visual material that they would like to use (like graffiti, statues, street art, performances, pamphlets, video mapping, posters, etc.) to sensibilize citizens and stakeholders. They also should decide how and why to put this element in the city/neighbourhood of the local workshop in question.

The products of these activities will be divided into two moments: a brief presentation (in powerpoint) in which each students group will present the imaginary scenario where they explain which tool and which visual material they would use and for what reasons and objectives. The second moment will be to show how they imagine this visual material, showing how it will be look like in the case study (like render, modified photos, descriptions, videos etc.).

The purposes of these activities are multiple. Beyond the Erasmus's spirit of internationalization and socialization, these activities aim at allowing each student to have sufficient knowledge of other tools used in the CLICCHE project by other partners and know how to use it. Using a visual element to raise awareness to citizens about climate change's issues is nothing new. Nevertheless, it is new to let the students reflect on this and make their own creative proposal.
