## TYPE AND LEVEL OF STUDY

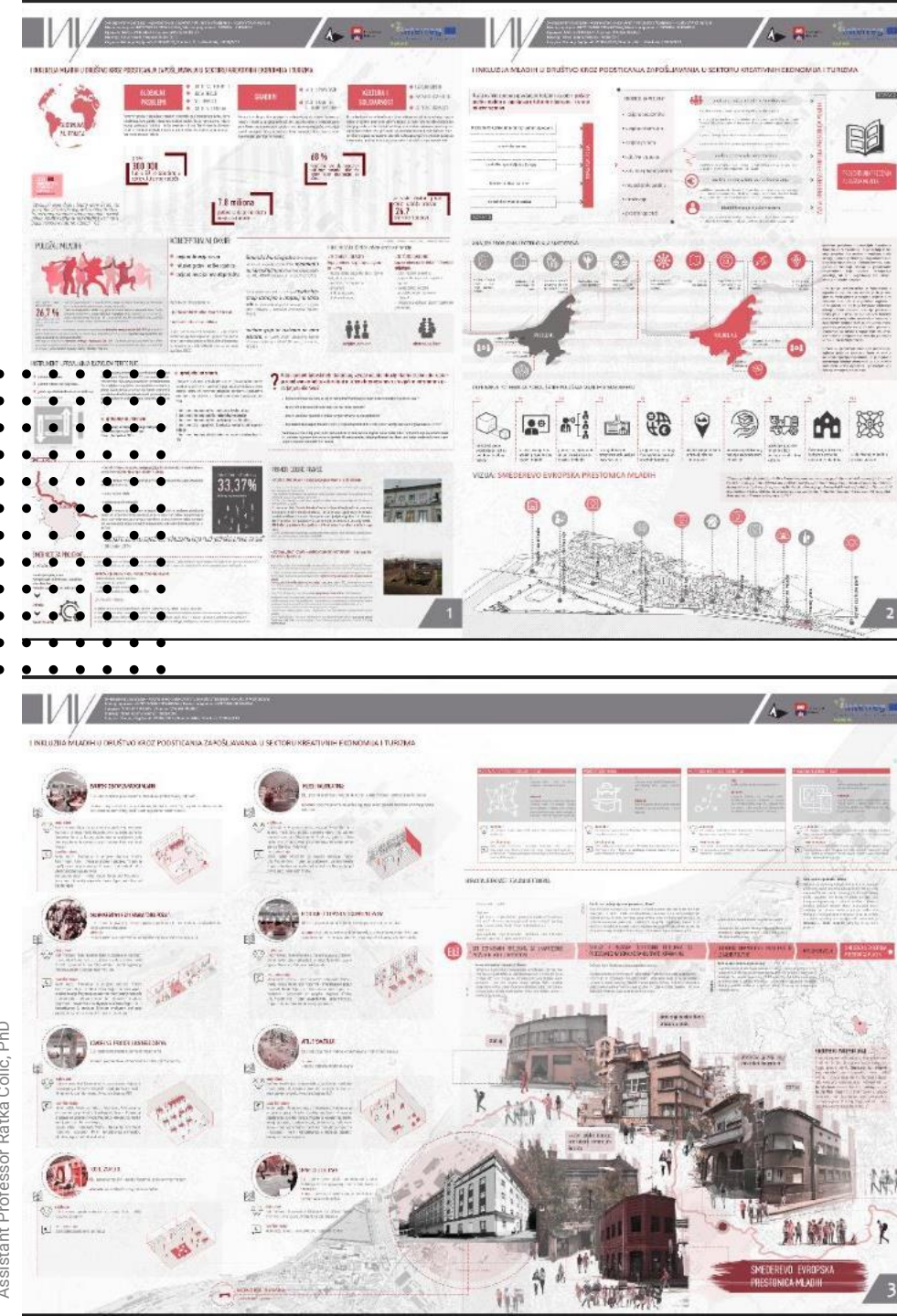
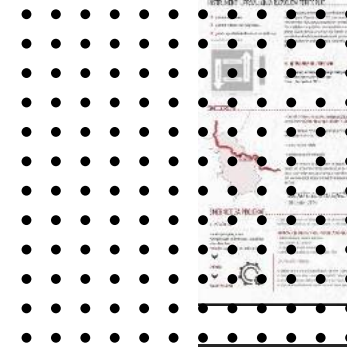
**UBFA Master in Integral Urbanism is a 2 years / 4 semesters (120 ECTS) full-time programme**, accredited by the National Accrediting Board. The course is offered in Serbian and English.

Upon completion of the program, students receive the title of **Master of Urbanism**. This study programme aims to provide future planners and urban designers with skills to create new solutions for effective, efficient and aesthetically satisfying organization and operation of the urban environment in a dynamic socio-economic and cultural environment with major impact on the urbanization process.

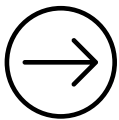
The study is realized within the following educational-scientific, ie educational-artistic fields:

Scholarships – 16; self-funding – 16.

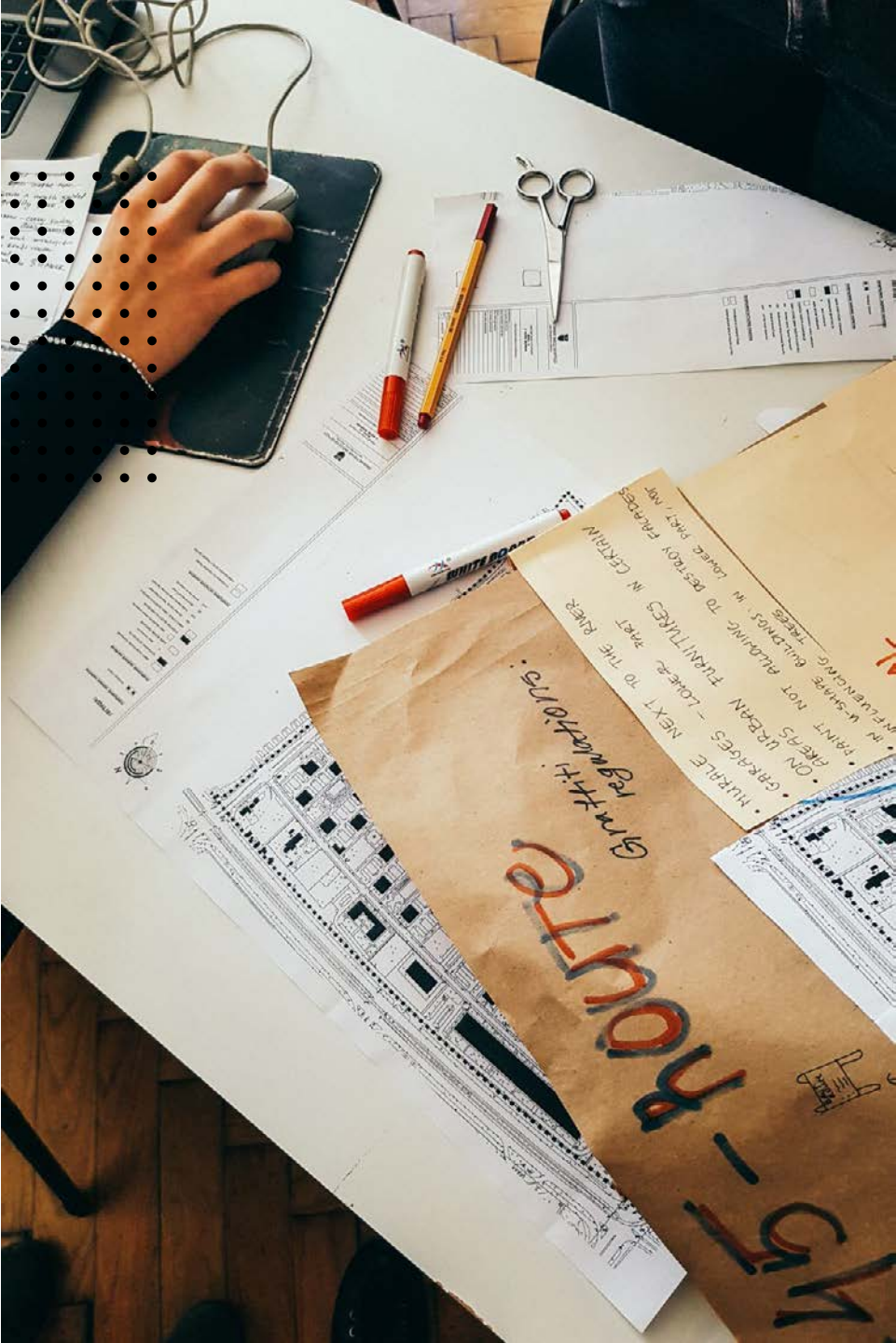
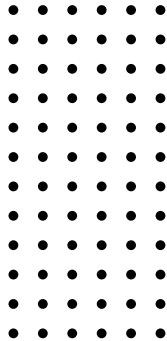
